'The Grand Portreeve of the Order of St George Chailey'

At the beginning of 2010 the society were looking at ideas for new fund raising events. We already had St Georges Day in the diary as it was about time somebody celebrated our patron saint and our village of Chailey has a number of St George connections. What we really needed was a focal point for the event, something to build towards the big day. We applied our usual rules of reason to the process; it needs to be fun, not too stressful, stand the chance of raising some money and benefit others as well as the society, so we settled on the idea of a 'Corrupt Election'. Not only was apparent corruption in politics rather topical, but we were aware of neighbouring villages and towns that had run similar events. It seemed to fit the bill rather well.

So, how does a corrupt election work? What we needed were candidates to put themselves forward for election to an honorary position and collect votes in the form of money. The winner would be the person who collected the most votes (money!) and only cash would count; pledges, promissory notes and IOUs would be burned! The incentive to enter is that the winner would keep the money raised for their favoured good cause/charity/local association or club. The runners up would donate half of their corrupt collections to the Bonfire Society, keeping the rest (?) for their favoured cause.

So what title would this honorary position have? We couldn't use titles such as 'Mayor' or 'Grand Master' as these were either official roles or already bagged by other organisations. Some research turned up the title of Portreeve. The term dates back to the Middle Ages and refers to a village elder or representative of the people, sometimes tasked with collecting taxes acting as a fiscal supervisor (rather apt for a corrupt election) and would always be a 'trustworthy person'. There are still some towns in the country where a Portreeve is still an honorary or even an official position.

On the 24th of April 2010 (the closest we could get to St Georges day), Mr Adrian Black was crowned 'The Grand Portreeve of the Order of St.George Chailey'. He has served his duties well since then, having received free entry to all Bonfire events, including the Pig Roast evening, and will have pride of place in the Bonfire procession on the 6th November. If you wish to put yourself forward as a candidate for the 2011 election, we would be pleased to hear from you.

Adrian Black with special campaign manager Clare Black, both long suffering members of The Bonfire Society raised £295 for Court Meadow School at Cuckfield where their daughter Phoebe attends. Court Meadow is a small special needs school which has children with various disabilities that require a multi sensory style curriculum.

The funds raised were given so that new and extra multi sensory equipment could be purchased for the children during their lunch breaks, this included DVD's CD's and touchy feely things. All of which were much appreciated and enjoyed by the children and a special card of thanks was created and given by Phoebes Class.
